

Nature & Wildlife in METRO Vancouver

Nature- & photo road trip through Metro Vancouver (about 4 hours)



What we'll be doing:

I'll be taking you in my car, a Nissan Rogue (AWD SUV) out of the city into nature. It will be a mixed ride & hike trip and I'll show you a few beautiful places in Metro Vancouver but **NOT within the city of Vancouver!** Each location is known not to be a tourist hotspot but offers nice natural views and hopefully some wildlife to take pictures of. Most of our stops have public washrooms. During the stops we'll be going on short hikes to get to the viewpoints and I will be taking pictures of the scenery and you. And I'll share the photos with all guests online the next day or so.

I'll pick you up and will drop you off at the end at the Lincoln Skytrain Station in Coquitlam. My car has room for 3 adult guests and one child. Cold drinks like water and pops as well as my charm 😊 and local knowledge are on board and included. Also, all parking fees and gas is included. Snacks, meals, coffee, tea or restaurant visits are not included. The 4-hour tour is CAD \$300 Dollar/Tour altogether. I can include more locations and extend it to a full day tour up to 8 hours. A full day tour would be CAD \$500 Dollar/Tour. The nature of the tour is seniors friendly and even persons with special needs are welcome to book.

Wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed. But during the summer, it is more than likely that we'll see some wildlife during the tour.

Station #1

At low tide with a short hike through a rain forest (15-30 minutes) to a hidden bay.

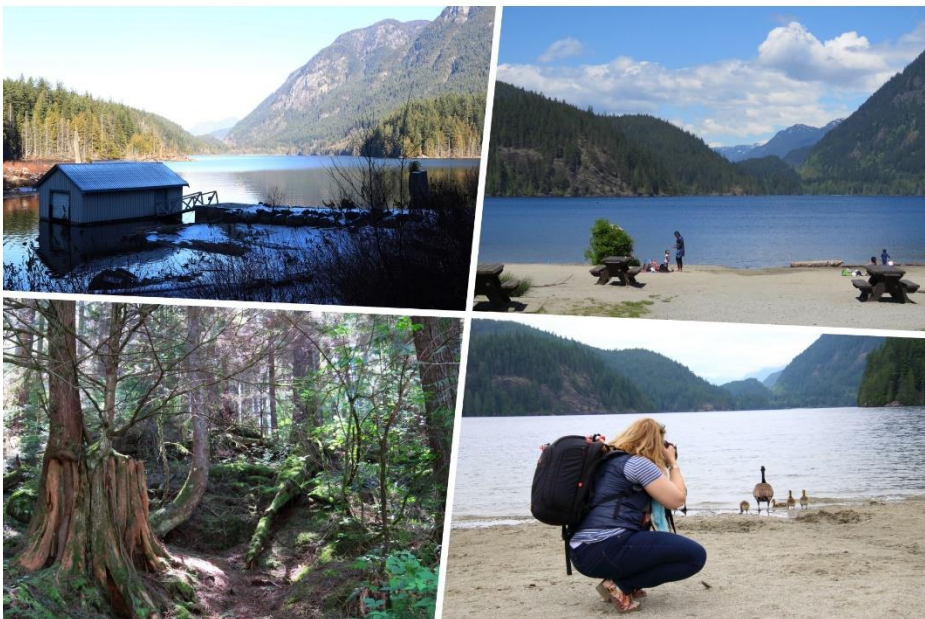


Specials:
View of North Vancouver and a board walk with usually lots of crab fishery going on.

Possible animal encounters:
Geese, Ducks, Seagulls, Seals, Crabs, Fish, Starfish, Eagles, Bears, Cormorants and other birds.

Station #2

Crystal clean, natural drinking water lake and reservoir surrounded by mountains and rain forest



Specials:
Natural drinking water reservoir and popular swimming lake.
Gorgeous location often used by film makers (X-Files)

Possible animal encounters:
Geese, Ducks, Seagulls, Eagles, Bears & other birds.

Station #3

Glacier lake with flat and easy hiking trails and lots of birds



Specials:

Just another gorgeous lake with flat trails, benches and lots of landscape-, waterscape- and wildlife photo opportunities. Ospreys are known to nest there close to the shoreline.

Possible animal encounters:

Ospreys, Coyotes, Cranes, Herons, Beaver, Otters, Geese, Ducks, Seagulls, Eagles, Bears and other animals.

Station #4

Viewpoint and Restaurant



Specials:

Panoramic view over Vancouver, Stanley Park, North Vancouver, the Indian arm and sometimes all the way to Vancouver Island. Best spot to watch sunsets. A fine dining (\$!) Restaurant is there as well.

Possible animal encounters:

Eagles, Coyotes, Squirrels, Raccoons, Bears and Birds.

I'll share the exact locations after booking is completed. Other locations are optional and might be visited instead, due to weather or other reasons. Pricing is per tour and not per person. For example, a tour booked by 3 individuals would be a third of the tour price per individual. If only one person books, the full tour price gets charged.
